<b>Delaware House of Representatives</b>	<b>David Levi Anderson District 31   Republican</b>
<b>Would you support legislation to change the age of a person who can purchase a firearm in Delaware from 18 to 21, similar to HB 330 (during the 149th General Assembly)?</b>	
<b>No</b>	<b>You are an adult or you are not. There is no evidence that makes us safer but it does insult those who serve in the military.</b>
<b>Would you support “unsafe storage of a firearm” legislation, which would revise the crime of ‘unlawfully permitting a child access to a firearm’ from a class A misdemeanor to a class B misdemeanor, similar to what was laid out in HB 366 (during the 149th General Assembly)?</b>	
<b>No</b>	<b>The current law works. the rate of Gun deaths by accident are down 90% since the 1970's. We should not blame the victims of theft.</b>
<b>Would you support efforts to prohibit the manufacture, sale, purchase, transfer, or delivery of large-capacity magazines, as they were defined in HB 375 (during the 149th General Assembly)?</b>	
<b>No</b>	<b>The bill did not even target real high capacity levels. 15 is not high capacity.</b>
<b>Would you support efforts to prohibit the manufacture, sale, offer to sell, transfer, purchase, receipt, possession, or transport of assault weapons in Delaware, as they were defined in SB 163 (during the 149th General Assembly)?</b>	
<b>No</b>	<b>Those were not assault weapons.</b>
<b>Would you support efforts to prohibit the manufacture, sale, offer to sell, transfer, purchase, receipt, possession, or transport of silencers (suppressors) in Delaware?</b>	
<b>No</b>	<b>Already banned in Delaware.</b>
<b>Would you oppose Concealed Carry Reciprocity legislation, which would allow anyone who can carry a concealed gun in one state to carry it another?</b>	
<b>No</b>	<b>I would actually sponsor that bill to allow it. It makes us safer. My uncle was saved during a robbery with 3 armed thugs because he carried.</b>
<b>Would you support legislation to ban the production, sale, transfer, distribution, possession, and use of 3D printed firearms?</b>	
<b>Yes</b>	<b>Depends on the wording.</b>
