<p>Would you support legislation to change the age of a person who can purchase a firearm in Delaware from 18 to 21, similar to HB 330 (during the 149th General Assembly)?</p>	
<p>Yes</p>	<p>For alcohol, it is already illegal to sell to anyone under age 21. Firearms cause more havoc than alcohol (in terms of years of potential life lost) and it is perfectly reasonable to raise the age at which they can be bought. Even though 18 year-olds can bear arms in military service where they are highly trained, it is a different matter in civilian life where there are no training requirements.</p>
<p>Would you support “unsafe storage of a firearm” legislation, which would revise the crime of ‘unlawfully permitting a child access to a firearm’ from a class A misdemeanor to a class B misdemeanor, similar to what was laid out in HB 366 (during the 149th General Assembly)?</p>	
<p>Yes</p>	<p>SurveyMonkey will not accept my answer, which is "Need more information on this proposal." The goal is clear: encourage the safe storage of firearms and penalize unsafe storage. If lowering this misdemeanor from class A to class B results in greater enforcement of the law and application of the penalty, it may make sense. I would need to hear the arguments for this case before really answering "Yes."</p>
<p>Would you support efforts to prohibit the manufacture, sale, purchase, transfer, or delivery of large-capacity magazines, as they were defined in HB 375 (during the 149th General Assembly)?</p>	
<p>Yes</p>	<p>We do not need military-grade weapons such as large capacity magazines in civilian use.</p>
<p>Would you support efforts to prohibit the manufacture, sale, offer to sell, transfer, purchase, receipt, possession, or transport of assault weapons in Delaware, as they were defined in SB 163 (during the 149th General Assembly)?</p>	
<p>Yes</p>	<p>We do not need military-grade weapons such as assault rifles in civilian use.</p>
<p>Would you support efforts to prohibit the manufacture, sale, offer to sell, transfer, purchase, receipt, possession, or transport of silencers (suppressors) in Delaware?</p>	
<p>Yes</p>	<p>Civilians do not need silencer technology for hunting and recreational shooting.</p>
<p>Would you oppose Concealed Carry Reciprocity legislation, which would allow anyone who can carry a concealed gun in one state to carry it another?</p>	
<p>Yes</p>	<p>We need to protect the sovereignty of the State of Delaware and should not be beholden to the laws of other states. We elect our legislators to represent us, not the citizens of other states. If the citizens of Delaware want a different standard on concealed gun carry than citizens in other states, that is our right under Federal law.</p>
<p>Would you support legislation to ban the production, sale, transfer, distribution, possession, and use of 3D printed firearms?</p>	
<p>Yes</p>	<p>Civilians do not need 3D printed firearms for hunting and recreational shooting.</p>
