Would you support legislation to change the age of a person who can purchase a firearm in Delaware from 18 to 21, similar to HB 330 (during the 149th General Assembly)?		
Yes	I am endorsed by the Sandy Hook Centre for my positions on gun legislation. My positions are well documented in detail on this.	
Would you support “unsafe storage of a firearm” legislation, which would revise the crime of ‘unlawfully permitting a child access to a firearm’ from a class A misdemeanor to a class B misdemeanor, similar to what was laid out in HB 366 (during the 149th General Assembly)?		
Yes	This is well thought out....Under this Act, the offense is a class B misdemeanor if there are no aggravating circumstances. If, however, the unauthorized person uses the firearm to commit a crime, uses the firearm to inflict serious physical injury or death upon anyone, or transfers the firearm to another unauthorized person, the offense is a class A misdemeanor. It is an affirmative defense that the person stored the firearm in a locked container, disabled it with a tamper-resistant trigger lock, or stored it in a location a reasonable person would have thought was safe from access by unauthorized persons.	
Would you support efforts to prohibit the manufacture, sale, purchase, transfer, or delivery of large-capacity magazines, as they were defined in HB 375 (during the 149th General Assembly)?		
Yes	I am consistent as being against military-style assault weapons. This includes large capacity magazines.	
Would you support efforts to prohibit the manufacture, sale, offer to sell, transfer, purchase, receipt, possession, or transport of assault weapons in Delaware, as they were defined in SB 163 (during the 149th General Assembly)?		
Yes	I have actively, and publicly, protested as a State House candidate, in Dover as well as Rehoboth Beach in support of SB163.	
Would you support efforts to prohibit the manufacture, sale, offer to sell, transfer, purchase, receipt, possession, or transport of silencers (suppressors) in Delaware?		
Yes	Yes, the same position as above, I am against military-style weapons and associated accessories.	
Would you oppose Concealed Carry Reciprocity legislation, which would allow anyone who can carry a concealed gun in one state to carry it another?		
Yes	Concealing and carrying is also an overreach I am strongly against.	
Would you support legislation to ban the production, sale, transfer, distribution, possession, and use of 3D printed firearms?		
Yes	Absolutely, having used 3d printers in my past occupation for hospital lab reproductions, I find this a necessity to stop misusing 3d printers to make guns before it becomes an active practice.
