Would you support legislation to change the age of a person who can purchase a firearm in Delaware from 18 to 21, similar to HB 330 (during the 149th General Assembly)?	
Yes	Gun ownership is a serious responsibility which should be taken extremely seriously, and limited where possible to ensure that.
Would you support “unsafe storage of a firearm” legislation, which would revise the crime of ‘unlawfully permitting a child access to a firearm’ from a class A misdemeanor to a class B misdemeanor, similar to what was laid out in HB 366 (during the 149th General Assembly)?	
No	The seriousness of the risk of allowing a child access to a firearm should be reflected in the class of misdemeanor which applies to the situation.
Would you support efforts to prohibit the manufacture, sale, purchase, transfer, or delivery of large-capacity magazines, as they were defined in HB 375 (during the 149th General Assembly)?	
Yes	Minimizing access to large capacity magazines is advisable, considering their role in recent mass shootings, a rare occurrence but a vital opportunity to avoid significant harm from bad actors.
Would you support efforts to prohibit the manufacture, sale, offer to sell, transfer, purchase, receipt, possession, or transport of assault weapons in Delaware, as they were defined in SB 163 (during the 149th General Assembly)?	
Yes	I understand this will be particularly challenging to advance, but I believe the fewer lethal weapons we have access to a citizens, the lower the risk of unnecessary harm to the public at large. This is the direction we should keep moving in.
Would you support efforts to prohibit the manufacture, sale, offer to sell, transfer, purchase, receipt, possession, or transport of silencers (suppressors) in Delaware?	
Yes	Silencers and other firearm accessories ought to be regulated, as firearms are.
Would you oppose Concealed Carry Reciprocity legislation, which would allow anyone who can carry a concealed gun in one state to carry it another?	
Yes	I think Delaware should be able to make the determination regarding permission for concealed carry. There is much variation in the qualification requirements across the states, so this would pose a risk to our own standards for concealed carry.
Would you support legislation to ban the production, sale, transfer, distribution, possession, and use of 3D printed firearms?	
Yes	This new development in firearm access should be taken very seriously, and carefully regulated (or banned) as we would other high risk weaponry.
