



# ★ DELAWARE COALITION AGAINST GUN VIOLENCE

<b>Delaware House of Representatives</b>		<b>Sean Lynn District 31   Democrat</b>	
<b>Would you support legislation to change the age of a person who can purchase a firearm in Delaware from 18 to 21, similar to HB 330 (during the 149th General Assembly)?</b>			
<b>Yes</b>	<b>I was a co-sponsor of HB330, because I believe that we should enact more common sense gun legislation.</b>		
<b>Would you support “unsafe storage of a firearm” legislation, which would revise the crime of ‘unlawfully permitting a child access to a firearm’ from a class A misdemeanor to a class B misdemeanor, similar to what was laid out in HB 366 (during the 149th General Assembly)?</b>			
<b>Yes</b>	<b>I was the prime sponsor of HB 366. Under this Act, the offense is a class B misdemeanor if there are no aggravating circumstances. If, however, the unauthorized person uses the firearm to commit a crime, uses the firearm to inflict serious physical injury or death upon anyone, or transfers the firearm to another unauthorized person, the offense is a class A misdemeanor.</b>		
<b>Would you support efforts to prohibit the manufacture, sale, purchase, transfer, or delivery of large-capacity magazines, as they were defined in HB 375 (during the 149th General Assembly)?</b>			
<b>Yes</b>	<b>I was a cosponsor of HB375.</b>		
<b>Would you support efforts to prohibit the manufacture, sale, offer to sell, transfer, purchase, receipt, possession, or transport of assault weapons in Delaware, as they were defined in SB 163 (during the 149th General Assembly)?</b>			
<b>Yes</b>	<b>I was a cosponsor for SB163.</b>		
<b>Would you support efforts to prohibit the manufacture, sale, offer to sell, transfer, purchase, receipt, possession, or transport of silencers (suppressors) in Delaware?</b>			
<b>Yes</b>	<b>This is an unnecessary tool that makes firearms far more dangerous than they need to be.</b>		
<b>Would you oppose Concealed Carry Reciprocity legislation, which would allow anyone who can carry a concealed gun in one state to carry it another?</b>			
<b>No</b>	<b>We should afford reciprocity and full faith and credit to other states concealed carry permit holders only if said process is equally as stringent as our own states process.</b>		
<b>Would you support legislation to ban the production, sale, transfer, distribution, possession, and use of 3D printed firearms?</b>			
<b>Yes</b>	<b>Our laws need to keep up with technological advancements.</b>
