<b>Would you support legislation to change the age of a person who can purchase a firearm in Delaware from 18 to 21, similar to HB 330 (during the 149th General Assembly)?</b>

<b>Would you support efforts to prohibit the manufacture, sale, purchase, transfer, or delivery of large-capacity magazines, as they were defined in HB 375 (during the 149th General Assembly)?</b>

<b>Would you support efforts to prohibit the manufacture, sale, offer to sell, transfer, purchase, receipt, possession, or transport of assault weapons in Delaware, as they were defined in SB 163 (during the 149th General Assembly)?</b>	
<b>Yes</b>	<b>My answer to this question is a qualified “yes”. SB 163 was modeled after an older Maryland law that has been upheld by the courts. I understand the importance of this position, but its application to Delaware, particularly given the passage of time, may require some revision to the definitions of the various prohibited weapons.</b>
<b>Would you support efforts to prohibit the manufacture, sale, offer to sell, transfer, purchase, receipt, possession, or transport of silencers (suppressors) in Delaware?</b>	
<b>Yes</b>	<b>My answer to this question is a qualified “yes”. I understand that silencers are relatively difficult to obtain today, and because of that, they are not generally used in the commission of crimes. Also, there may be legitimate reasons that persons permitted to use a firearm would want to use a silencer, for instance, to protect their hearing. I would want to explore these issues more thoroughly before deciding whether to support the specific legislation.</b>
