Would you support legislation to change the age of a person who can purchase a firearm in Delaware from 18 to 21, similar to HB 330 (during the 149th General Assembly)?	
No	It is an unnecessary law.
Would you support “unsafe storage of a firearm” legislation, which would revise the crime of ‘unlawfully permitting a child access to a firearm’ from a class A misdemeanor to a class B misdemeanor, similar to what was laid out in HB 366 (during the 149th General Assembly)?	
No	Responsible gun owners are responsible. Would you support a law making abortions of the children you reference a felony murder offence?
Would you support efforts to prohibit the manufacture, sale, purchase, transfer, or delivery of large-capacity magazines, as they were defined in HB 375 (during the 149th General Assembly)?	
No	I do not believe this change would effect the murder rate or gun violence in Delaware and no facts have been presented to support such an assumption.
Would you support efforts to prohibit the manufacture, sale, offer to sell, transfer, purchase, receipt, possession, or transport of assault weapons in Delaware, as they were defined in SB 163 (during the 149th General Assembly)?	
No	True military assault weapons are already highly regulated by the federal government. Your mis-labeling of look a like weapons is ridiculous and has no factual basis.
Would you support efforts to prohibit the manufacture, sale, offer to sell, transfer, purchase, receipt, possession, or transport of silencers (suppressors) in Delaware?	
No	Silencers are already illegal to own in Delaware, this question is a display of your ignorance to existing laws.
Would you oppose Concealed Carry Reciprocity legislation, which would allow anyone who can carry a concealed gun in one state to carry it another?	
No	The person with the CCDW permit has already proven they are a responsible and safe gun owner.
Would you support legislation to ban the production, sale, transfer, distribution, possession, and use of 3D printed firearms?
